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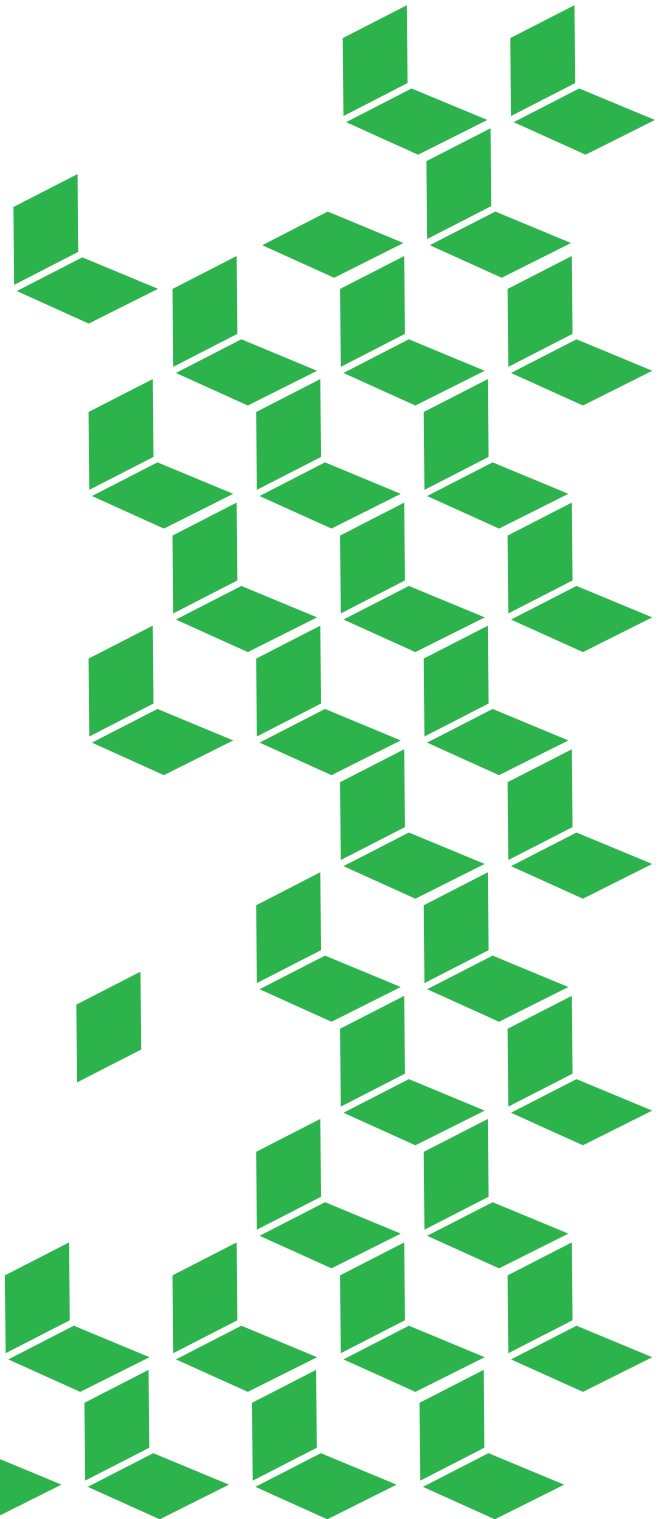

Navigating EU access to finance and grants opportunities for Creative Hubs. How European Programmes support them to realize their ideas and boost the creative economy. Focus on the Creative Europe programme as well as on other EU funding programmes.

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During this session, Barbara Stacher, project officer of the EU-Commission, introduced several calls for artists and creative people with relevance for Creative Hubs:

As Barbara noted during the session, it is very important for hubs participating in different proposals also to build in some components in support of the Network as such. She also suggested that Creative Europe desks and also Horizon Desks all over Europe can help to provide applicants with the necessary information, help with drafting and finding partners. Barbara discussed with the participants their experience with Erasmus+, H2020, STARTS, COSME, Worth and the StartUp Europe programme. She also explained different new initiatives concerning mobility schemes for artists and creative professionals, different pilot projects and smaller actions and upcoming calls.
